

# 122 new objects

A major breakthrough may have been achieved in the search for flight MH370 in the southern Indian Ocean. It was announced yesterday that another French satellite had detected 122 objects, 2,557km from Perth, near areas where authorities believe the plane went down. The acting transport minister said the "objects appeared to be bright, possibly indicating solid materials".
